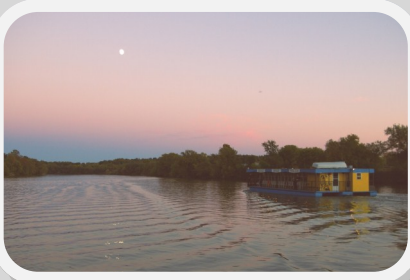

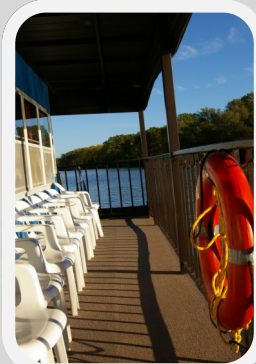

### Add a guided tour of the Six Nations to your day

During your cruise, the Six Nations runs along the south shore of the Grand River and the captain will give some commentary about the land. If you wish to learn more about the Six Nations a guided tour is available after your cruise. A Guide from Six Nations Tourism will board your bus at our facilities and take you on a 1 hour tour of the Reserve. Throughout the tour, your guide will give you insight into their past and present culture. A stop at a Native Craftshop is also included. Only available to groups traveling by bus

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

**Do you have menu options?** We can substitute the roast beef portion with pasta or chicken. We also have diabetic and gluten free substitutes. We can accommodate almost all dietary needs, if you have a request please let us know ahead of time. **All substitutions must be ordered 24 hours prior to cruise.**

**Are your boats air-conditioned?** No, however they are well ventilated.

**Is gratuity included in the prices?** No. We suggest adding it to your payment or give it directly to the staff.

**Do you have a complimentary policy?** Complimentary passes are given to the group leader if you have 35 paying guests and to a bus driver if arriving by bus.
