
Cruises are by reservation only, and run from late May through early October.

⦿ Additional Information

- **Payment & Deposit:** No deposit is required to reserve, however a 50% deposit is required 14 days prior with your final count and menu choices. Balance is due on arrival and you can adjust your numbers up to 24 hours prior to cruise.
- **Menu:** Menu choices must be ordered when final numbers are confirmed. Meal is plated in kitchen and served to each table (not a buffet). We can accommodate almost any food allergy or intolerance if we have advance notice prior to day of cruise.
- **Bar:** Our boats are licensed to serve alcohol with bar service available on all cruises. No outside alcohol is permitted however you may bring your own wine (no homemade wine) with a \$10 corkage fee per bottle. Arrangements can be made for a cash bar, host bar or a combination of both.
- **Table Arrangements:** All of our boats have tables seating 6 people on the port side and tables seating 4 people on the starboard side with an aisle down the middle.
- **Capacity:** Maximum capacity is 49 passengers (excluding crew) - we now have 1 boat that has a maximum capacity of 54 passengers.
- **Accessibility:** All our boats are wheelchair accessible and have an accessible washroom.
- **Children's rates:** Ages 13-17 are \$50, 6-12 are: \$35, 2-5 are \$10 and under 2 are no charge.
- **Gratuities:** A 10% gratuity is included in the price that is split amongst your captain and serving crew.
- **Comps:** Complimentary passes are given to the tour escort and bus driver.
